

- 1. History of Corner Establishment and Subsequent Restoration: CORNER ORIGINALLY ESTABLISHED BY ODELL & LEWIS IN 1865 UNDER CONT-RACT NO. 110, AS "A POST FOR 1/4 CORNER". CRIGER, IN 1953, SHOWS CORNER AS A "PIPE". (SEE SURVEY Q-1039, UMATILLA CO. SURVEYOR). MELTON, IN 1951, DOES NOT DESCRIBE THE CORNER, BUT DOES SHOW THE NORTH LINE OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 AS BEING ALONG A FENCELINE, THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SAID SOUTHWEST 1/4 BEING AN "OLD FENCE CORNER"
- 2. Description of Evidence Found: NO DIRECT EVIDENCE FOUND. CORNER FALLS IN A PLOWED FIELD. AT FENCE CORNER 1/2 MILE TO EAST I FOUND A 5/8" IRON BAR, AND AT FENCE COR-NER 1/2 MILE SOUTH I FOUND A BRASS CAP ON A PIPE WITH BASALT STONE ALONGSIDE. FROM THESE TWO CORNERS I RE-ESTABLISHED THE WEST 1/4 CORNER AT THE RECORD DISTANCES SHOWN ON THE AFOREMENTIONED CRIGER SURVEY.
