MONUMENT SET:

Corner area falls in wheat field with no nearby features. Corner position was re-established by single proportion measurement, midway between the Northwest and Northeast corners of Section 24. At re-established corner position, set a 2 1/2" brass cap on a 1 1/4" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with cap 18" below ground level.

New accessories:

A silver deep-1 magnet buried 20" below ground level, bears North 50° East, 34.3 feet. A purple deep-1 magnet buried 20" below ground level, bears South 28 1/2° East, 42.4 feet.
