## MONUMENT SET:

The corner falls in a wheat field with no nearby features. I recovered certain features from J.W. Kimbrell's 1900 Survey No. 124, and held these features to re-establish this corner position, as described in "Detail" on Sheet 2 of 2 of the accompanying Record of Survey. At the re-established corner position, set a 2 1/2" brass cap on a 2 1/2" by 30" galvanized iron pipe with cap 20" below ground surface, marked as shown in Monument Marking Detail. New accessories:

A silver deep-1 magnet buried 20" in the ground bears North 61° East, 43.2 feet. A purple deep-1 magnet buried 20" in the ground bears South 53° East, 56.8 feet. A blue deep-1 magnet buried 20" in the ground bears South 63° West, 36.1 feet. An orange deep-1 magnet buried 20" in the ground bears North 46° West, 48.8 feet. Buried bearing object signs with all deep-1 magnets.
