Survey No. B-1-A, by Harris in 1965, calls for a 1 1/2" pipe. Survey No. 01-97-B, by Harris, in 2001, calls for a 2" I. Pipe.

MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES FOUND:

Found a 1 ½" outside diameter iron pipe, set in concrete, protruding 13" above ground level, 1 foot West of railroad tie post in H-brace.

MONUMENT MARKING DETAIL: The corner monument is a 1 1/2" diameter o.d. pipe.

A 3/4" brass washer stamped "PLS 1106", 1 foot above ground level in a railroad tie fence post bears South 49° East, 8.7 feet.

A 5/8" x 24" iron rebar with yellow plastic cap stamped "OR PLS 1106, WA PLS 17372", cap set 1" above ground level, bears North 87° West, 24.6 feet.

A 5/8" x 24" iron rebar with yellow plastic cap stamped "OR PLS 1106, WA PLS 17372", cap set 1" above ground level, bears North 87° West, 61.1 feet.

Attached bearing object signs to rebar accessories and to railroad tie post with brass washer. Attached "witness" sign to railroad tie post 1 foot East of monument.
