In Record of Private Surveys, Survey No. 106 states: the 1/4 Sec. corner between Sec. 28 & 29 was recovered and noted at a point with fences North, West and South. Survey No. 182 reports identical measurements.

MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES FOUND: Intersection of a East-West fence line and well defined field berm running South.

MONUMENT SET:

I held the intersection of a East-West fence line with a well defined field berm running South as best remaining evidence of the original corner position. At re-established corner position, set a 2 1/2" brass cap on a 2 1/2" x 30" iron pipe, 28" in the ground. Cap marked as shown on Monument Marking Detail.

New accessories:

A 5/8" x 30" iron rebar with a 1 1/4" yellow plastic cap stamped "OR PLS 1106, WA PLS 17372", with the cap 1" above ground level, in East-West fence line, bears East, 36.9 feet. A purple deep-1 magnet, buried 20" in the ground, bears South 25° East, 48.8 feet. A blue deep-1 magnet, buried 20" in the ground, bears South 54° West, 61.8 feet. A 5/8" x 30" iron rebar with a 1 1/4" yellow plastic cap stamped "OR PLS 1106, WA PLS 17372", with the cap 1" above ground level, bears West, 42.8 feet. Buried bearing object signs with deep-1 magnets. Attached bearing object signs to rebar accessories. Attached "witness post" to railroad tie 8 feet West of brass cap monument.
