

Previous Renewals / Surveys, etc.

Corner originally set by Odell and Lewis under contract No. 110 dated February 7, 1865. Their record reads: Set 1/4 sec. post on hill side facing S.E., drove charred stake, dug pits, and raised mound as per instructions.; John Kimbrell in the Record of Private Surveys Book 1, Page 374 states: Set stone 18x6x5 for 1/4 sec. corner.

Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source)

The stone by Kimbrell 6x4x6 inches above ground in a mound of stone on a S.E. facing hill side. The stone was unmarked but was distinct and in an obvious mound.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description)

At the position of Kimbrell's stone I set a 1 1/2" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with a 2 1/4" brass cap stamped as shown above flush with the surface in the old mound.

For references, I set four 5/8" by 24" iron rebars with 1 1/4" orange plastic caps stamped WTS and 56295LS as described below:

an iron rebar bears S72°07'28"W, 56.47 feet;

an iron rebar bears S9°58'45"W, 32.03 feet; an iron rebar bears N6°43'56"E, 29.75 feet;

an iron rebar bears N80°11'54"E, 37.28 feet;

The monument and references were tied using a Trimble R7/R8 RTK GPS system.
