PREVIOUS RENEWALS/SURVEYS ETC: Corner originally established by George S. Pershin, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, under Contract No. 373, dated September 17, 1880. Notes state: Set pine post and marked stone 10x5x3, dug pits and raised mound of earth on level for corner to sections 2, 3, 10, and 11.

MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES FOUND: Found 12x6x3 inch stone in mound of four stones marked with two notches on East edge. The four stones surrounding the corner stone were found underneath pasture sod.

MONUMENT SET: At position of found stone set a 2 3/8" brass cap on 1 1/4"x30" galvanized iron pipe with the cap flush with ground level in small mound of stone. Buried the original stone on the North side of the monument with notches visible. Cap is marked as shown in "Monument Marking Detail."

A 5/8"x24" iron rebar with 1 1/4" red plastic cap stamped "OR PLS 1106 WA PLS 17372", flush with ground level bears N 55° E, 33.3 feet.

A 5/8"x24" iron rebar with 1 1/4" red plastic cap stamped "OR PLS 1106 WA PLS 17372", 3" above ground level bears S 24° E, 36.0 feet.

A 5/8"x24" iron rebar with 1 1/4" red plastic cap stamped "OR PLS 1106 WA PLS 17372", 3" above ground level bears S 53° W, 37.1 feet.

A 5/8"x24" iron rebar with 1 1/4" red plastic cap stamped "OR PLS 1106 WA PLS 17372", 3" above ground level bears N 28° W, 33.8 feet.

Attached bearing object signs to all rebar accessories. Attached Witness sign to brass cap monument.

LOCATION AND COMMENTS: Corner is located in level pasture land approximately 200 feet West of the base of a steep hill. Corner is in the remains of a old North-South fence line about 40 South of scattered stones of a old rock jack.
