
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At the corner position a 2 inch by 30 inch iron pipe, with brass cap marked as shown, was set 15 inches in the around and surrounded with a mound of stones to the cap.

Set steel fence posts on property line North of corner and attached signs 54-2 and 54-9.

Established 2 new BT's: A 7" red fir bears S8° E 17.9 ft. scribed W 1/16 S 30 BT.

A 8" Tamarack bears N80°W 15.9 ft. scribed W 1/16 S 19 BT.

BT's have lower blaze scribed BT with a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to it.

BT's have 54-3 and 54-4 signs attached and a 6" red band painted around them above blaze.
