

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At the corner position a 2 inch by 30 inch iron pipe, with brass cap marked as shown, was set 18 inches in the ground and surrounded with a mound of stones to the cap.

Set steel fence post North and West of corner and attached signs 54-2 and 54-9.

Established 2 new BT's: A 14½" bull pine bears N 16½°W 39.8 ft. scribed SE 1/16 S 30 BT.

A 21" bull pine bears N20°E 62.2 ft. scribed SE 1/16 S 30 BT.

BT's have 54-3 and 54-4 signs attached and a 6" red band painted around them above blaze.
