A Lodgepole, 8" dia., dead and down, with scribing visible, the stump of which bears N21°W, 6.2 ft.

A Lodgepole, 7" dia., dead and down, with scribing visible, the root hole of which bears S23°W, 24.7 ft.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Mark new BTs:

A Tamarack, 9" dia., S21 $^{10}$ E, 67.0 ft. marked: CN 1/16 S3 BT A Tamarack, 7" dia., S490W, 117.0 ft. marked: CN 1/16 S3 BT

BTs have blazes and a 6" stripe painted red, a BT tag and a "Land Survey Monument" sign. New BTs have, additionally, an alum. "PLS 1832" washer nailed to the bottom of the blaze. There is a 6' steel fence post with a "Land Survey Monument" sign within 5' of the corner.

Measured to center of BTs using steel tape and staff compass. Magnetic declination set at  $16^{\circ}\text{E}$ .
