
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner established under G.L.O. Contract No. 430, in 1882 by George S. Pershin. Surveyor General's records state: Set basalt stone 16x7x6 in. 11 ins. in ground on level at small grove of Pine Trees for 1/4 Sec. Cor. marked 1/4 on W. face from which:

A Pine 8 ins. dia. brs. S58°E, 23 lks. dist marked 1/4 S BT. a Pine 7 ins. dia. brs. N51°W, 33 lks. dist marked 1/4 S BT.



Description of corner evidence found:

Found original stone 16"x7"x6" - 10" in ground with visible " $\frac{1}{4}$ " on west face. Cound find no evidence of original Bearing Trees.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

In place of original stone set 2 1/2"x30" galvanized pipe with brass cap stamped:

Set pipe 24" in ground with mound of stone to cap and original stone buried alongside.

New Bearing Trees: A Lodge Pole Pine 7" in dia. bears $\$76^{0}$ W, 45.5 ft., scribed 1/4 S2 BT. A Lodge Pole Pine 5" dia. bears $\$85^{0}$ E, 149.7 ft., scribed 1/4 S**1** BT.

Attached 54-3 & 54-4 signs to both BTs. Attached brass washer stamped LS1294 to foot blaze of both BTs. Painted blazes and 6" band around both BTs Red. Attached 54-2 & 54-4 signs to metal post 3 ft. west of corner.
