Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner By Proportionate Method

Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " dia. Brass Cap on a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " \times 30" galvanized pipe 15" in the ground and a mound of stones around the Brass Cap which is stamped as shown:

From which I scribed the Bearing Trees

A 12" dia. Pondarosa Pine bears N 48° E, 15.9 feet scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S 20 BT

A 8" dia. Pondarosa Pine bears N 39° W, 25.1 feet scribed & S 19 BT

Bearing trees have: A Brass Washer stamped PLS 933 nailed to the BT scribe, a painted band around the tree and on the face of the scribe, signs # 54-3 & 54-4

Bearing trees were measured horizontally with a steel tape to the center of the tree and a magnetic compass with a 19° East variation.

Also set a steel fence post with sign # 54-4 by Brass Cap Aug. 6, 1984
