In 1977 the BLM remonumented this corner and found the original stone loosely set 1" in the ground and; a root hole bears N 69° E, 239 lks with a down and decayed pine alongside, size indeterminate, and a pine, 38" dia., bears S 64° E, 279 lks with framentary scribe marks.

They scribed a new bearing tree, a Lodgepole pine, 18" dia., bears N 59½° E, 308 lks, marked T 5 S, R 33 E, S 20 BT


