CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

George S. Pershin under G.L.O. Contract No. 430, dated Mar. 23, 1882, set a basalt stone 16"x 10"x 7", 11" in ground, marked 1 on N. face. From corner: Tamarack 26" dia., N58°E, 14 1ks. Fir, 20" dia., N70°W, 33 1ks.

Craig L. Wanless, Cadastral Surveyor, under special instructions, Group No. 350, found a basalt stone 16"x 10"x 7" marked 1. He set a 21"x 28" iron post with brass cap marked:

From corner: Larch, 40" dia., N70°E, 14 lks.; scribing visible. (orig. BT) Root hole, N70°W,33 lks.; down and decayed fir alongside;

scribing visible. (orig. BT)
Grand Fir, 10" dia., N510W, 19 lks. (new BT)

Description of corner evidence found:

I found a 2½" iron pipe with a 3½" brass cap (BLM) marked as above. Monument is in mound of stone. From the corner:

Douglas Fir, 13" dia., N510W, 12.5 ft.; scribing visible.

W. Larch, 37" dia., N70°E, 9.2 ft.; "; tree is d ; tree is dying.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: I marked new BTs:

Douglas Fir, 12" dia., N21°E, 10.5 ft.; marked: \(\frac{1}{2}\) S29 BT Ponderosa Pine, 12" dia., S72\(\frac{1}{2}\)°E, 9.3 ft.; marked: \(\frac{1}{2}\) S29 BT Ponderosa Pine, 8" dia., S21\(\frac{1}{2}\)°E, 55.8 ft.; marked \(\frac{1}{2}\) S29 BT

BTs have blaze and a 6" band painted red, BT tags and "Land Survey Monument" signs. New BTs have, additionally, alum. "PLS 1832" washers nailed to the bottom of the blaze. There is a 6' steel fence post with a "Land Survey Monument" sign within 5' of the corner.

Measured to center of BTs using steel tape and staff compass. Magnetic declination set at $19^{\circ}E_{\bullet}$.
