1. HISTORY:

Corner originally established by Daniel G. Major under Contract No. 72, dated May 5, 1863. Record states: Set post for corner to Sections 7, 8, 17, 18 on side of high hill. Built mound deposited charred stake, dug trench & pits. Bearing to Tree on Walla Walla N 58°23'E, dist 4 3/4 miles Rock abutting from high ridge S 84°07' W dist 2 1/2 miles.

Corner is shown as "Old Gov't Cor-Rock" on survey plat by L.W. Lochr for George Lambdin, File # 2-S-047, Walla Walla County Engineer's Office.

2. EVIDENCE FOUND:

At fence corner with fences extending East and South, found and uprooted 16 x 12 x 6" basalt stone, marked "X".

3. PERPETUATION INFORMATION:

At a point on the SE side of the fence corner, set a 2 1/4" brass cap on a 1" x 30" galvanized iron pipe 6 inches above ground. Placed marked stone alongside. Cap is marked:

T6N R32E S7 | S8 S18|S17 2001 **OPLS 1106** WPLS 17372

The second steel fence post from fence corner in fence running East bears N 90° E, 65.0 feet. The second steel fence post from fence corner in fence running South bears S 04° W, 61.6 feet. Set steel fence post North of new monument. Measured bearings and distances to steel fence posts are at ground level. Compass declination 18°East.
