
Previous Renewals/Surveys, etc: Originally surveyed by U.S. Deputy Surveyor William Odell under his contract No. 110, dated 8-23-1865. The Surveyor Generals notes state, "set 1/4 section post, drove charred stake, dug pits, and raised mounds as per instructions." Umatilla County Road No. 308 survey, dated 1888, Arnold set a stone 15"x13"x10" marked ¼ on west face of the surveyed position. A 1951 survey by Meltonand Criger shows ¼ corner found. Umatilla County survey No. 9121-C, dated 2-10-1991, Tomkins Land Surveying found a basalt stone 2 1/2 feet below ground with a "+" on topand marked 1/4 on the west face and set a 2 1/2" brass cap on a 1"x30" galvanized iron pipe.


