
Previous Renewals/Surveys, etc.: Not set a part of the original government survey county survey No. 59, Book 1, Page 267, dated May 10, 1894, Arnold set a smooth basalt stone 18"x8"x7" 18" in the ground marked 1/4 on the south face. Survey Q-822-A dated 5-2-56, Newbill indicates that he set an iron pin at the intersection of the North and South centerline of section 13 with the state line. Survey A-39-AX by Thompson shows a 1/2" iron pipe, survey No. 84-172-B, dated 12-18-84, shows they found a 1/2" pipe per survey No. A-39-AX. The plat of Tum-A-Lum Heights, Book 13, Page 5, dated March 1985, shows a found a 5/8" iron pipe with an aluminum cap stamped PLS 933.


Monument(s) & Accessories Found (Condition & Source):

Attached a Umatilla County Bearing object to the northwest face of power pole. A 5/8 rebar with yellow plastic cap stamped 'Tomkins Surveying' which bears S $58^\circ\text{W} \sim 43.45$ feet from the corner. Set a concrete nail with brass tag "wa 19619 or 2820" in the center of west bound travel lane added "bo" to tag. A 5/8 rebar with yellow plastic cap stamped 'Tomkins Surveying' which bears N $70^\circ\text{W} \sim 40.00$ feet from the corner. Attached a Umatilla County Bearing object to a t-post.
