

The Surveyor Generals notes state, "set a post corner for sections 21, 22, 27, and 28, drove charred stake, dug pits, and raised mounds as per instructions." Survey No. 53, Book 1, Page 250, dated April 21, 1892, Arnold found a stone 21"x18"x15" set in location of original comer by land owner. Survey Q-835-C, dated 10-15-62, Harris found a railroad spike. Survey H-40-A, dated August 16, 1971, Staebler found an iron pipe and set a brass cap in concrete.
