
Previous Renewals/Surveys, etc.: Originally surveyed by U.S. Deputy Surveyor William Odell under his contract No. 110, dated 8-23-1865. The Surveyor Generals notes state, "set post corner for sections 20,21,28, and 29. Drove charred stake, dug pits, and raised mounds as per instructions." Survey No. 35, dated October 15, 1888, Book 1, Page 188, Arnold set a flat oval shaped boulder 12"x7"x4", 8" below the bottom of a ditch from evidence of the original corner post. Survey I-4, dated 1975, Dwyer found a brass screw. Circa 1995, The Oregon Department of Transportation resurfaced the road and set a brass cap in monument case.



Attached a Umatilla County Bearing object to the northeast face of a locust fence post. A 5/8 rebar with yellow plastic cap stamped 'Tomkins Surveying' which bears N $47^{\circ}W \sim 32.56$ feet from the corner. Attached a Umatilla County Bearing object to the south face of a railroad tie fence post.
