

The Surveyor General's notes state, "set post corner for sections 29,30,31, and 32. Drove a charred stake, dug pits and raised mounds as per instructions. County Survey No. 35, Book 1, Page 188, dated October 15, 1888, Arnold found a stone set by land owner William Weaver, circa 1884, over the remains of the original charred stake. In 1973, Streamer found a 1/2" steel pin of unknown origin as shown on survey No. I-089-AX.


Monument(s) & Accessories Found (Condition & Source):
