

Section 34 Township 6 N Range 35E County Umatilla Date: Jan. 2001 Condition Report Only Corner Designation: 6n35z17 Not found Remonumented Previous Renewals / Surveys, etc. Unrecorded This corner was established by Odell and Lewis under Surveyed in Contract 110 dated Feb. 7, 1865. The corner was Referenced out monumented with posts and pits. In or before 1879, the Oregon-Washington Railroad & Navigation Co. tied it from station 578+66 at an angle right of 66°54' at 1549.7 feet and also from station 577+00 at an angle right of 61°28' at 1618 feet. My copy of this survey is dated 1916. In 1974 under survey I-198-A, Harris set a 1/2" pin. In 1981 under survey S-157-C, Krumbein set a brass cap at the position of the 1/2" pin. Monument and Accessories found: (condition and source) Found Krumbeins brass cap 1" below the road surface in good condition.



MONUMENT (S) AND ACCESSORIES SET (Procedures and Description)

At a point based on the railroad's record distance north from the tracks and at the approximate centerline of the county road, I set a 1 1/4" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with a 2 1/2" brass cap stamped as shown in the diagram above. The top of the cap is 1/4" below the paved surface. REFERENCES SET:

The previous corner monument, a 2 1/2" brass cap by PLS 933 bears S2°34'25"E, 14.71'. 5/8" x 24" rebars with 1.3" red plastic caps stamped ORLS 852 and WALS 13922 were set & bear: N80°16'24"W, 35.57'; N16°28'48"E, 54.75'; S58°25'00"E, 25.45'.
