
Previous Renewals/Surveys, etc.: Originally surveyed by U.S. Deputy Surveyor William Odell under his contract No. 110, dated 8-23-1875. The Surveyor General's notes state, "set post corner for sections 35,36,1, and 2, drove a charred stake, dug pits and raised mounds as per instructions." County Survey No. 6, Book 1, Page 15, dated July 30, 1880, by the County Surveyor, Raley found government corner post and set a basalt rock and raised a mound of stones. County Survey No. A-41-AX, dated December 1965, Thompson set a brass cap.

Monument(s) & Accessories Found (Condition & Source):

At the southwest corner of section 36, T6N R35E, we found a 2 1/2" brass cap in 3" outside diameter iron pipe filled with concrete 5" above the ground.
