J. H. Raley, County Surveyor, recovered this corner in survey recorded in Book 1, Page 51, Record of Private Surveys. Raley does not state what was found for the corner.

Don Staebler did not recover this corner and calculated a position for it, mid-way between the Northeast and Southeast Corner of Section 20 in Survey No. K-79-B, in 1974.

MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES FOUND: None. Corner falls in North-South field berm.

MONUMENT SET: Corner point was reestablished by single proportionate measure between the recovered and accepted Northeast and Southeast Corners of Section 20. At the reestablished corner point, set a 2 3/8" brass cap on 1 1/4" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with cap buried 18" below ground level, marked as shown in "Monument Marking Detail".
