John Kimbrell, in his survey recorded at Book 1, Page 492, Record of Private Surveys, surveyed to this corner but does not state what was found.

MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES FOUND: None.

MONUMENT MARKING DETAIL:

T6N R36E 1/4 S35 | S36 2008 PLS 1106

MONUMENT SET: Held a point just South of a 6" well casing in a North-South field berm as best remaining evidence of the original corner location. At the reestablished corner point, set a 2 3/8" brass cap on a 1 1/4" x 30" galvanized iron pipe, with cap flush with the ground, marked as shown in "Monument Marking Detail".

New accessories:

A silver deep-1 magnet bears North 48° East, 36.8 feet.

A purple deep-1 magnet bears South 54 1/2° East, 29.2 feet.

A blue deep-1 magnet bears South 60 1/2° West, 46.2 feet.

An orange deep-1 magnet bears North 39° West, 33.3 feet.

Deep-1 magnets are buried 24" below ground level with bearing object signs. Wired witness sign to well casing North of the corner monument.

LOCATION AND COMMENTS: Well casing stands 4 feet above ground level painted white. A field berm extends South and North from corner point. There is a field road about 25 feet South of corner.
