#### MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES FOUND:

Found an old iron pipe 1 1/4" I.D. x 22 1/2" long lying on its side about 8" deep and 20 feet southeast of the corner monument set in this survey. The significance of the pipe is unknown but it matches the length and type of monument set by Kimbrell in a survey done 4 days earlier to the east of this location. There was also evidence of ferrous material (possibly rust) at the location I set the corner monument.

MONUMENT SET (PROCEDURES AND DESCRIPTION): Accepted the intersection of the center of the gravel road and a north-south plow line to the south as the best evidence of the corner location and set a 5/8" x 30" iron rebar with yellow plastic cap marked "UCPWD...LS2627" 4" below the road surface.

### NEW ACCESSORIES:

The 1 1/4" X 22 1/2" iron pipe was buried 18" deep and a 5/8" X 7" iron rebar with yellow plastic cap marked "UCPWD...LS2627" was driven in the top. The center of the cap bears S2\*16'48"E, 21.64' from corner. WITNESS: A bearing object tag and "DO NOT DISTURB" sign are nailed to a line post 0.7' southwesterly of the pipe.

A 5/8" X 30" iron rebar with yellow plastic cap marked "UCPWD...LS2627" bears S22°27'36"W, 25.43' from corner. A bearing object tag is wired to the monument.

A 5/8" X 30" iron rebar with yellow plastic cap marked "UCPWD...LS2627" and buried 3" below road surface bears N3  $^{\circ}46$  16 W, 10.94' from corner.

A 5/8" X 30" iron rebar with yellow plastic cap marked "UCPWD...LS2627" bears S21°44'50"E, 23.74' from corner. A bearing object tag is wired to the monument.
