
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishments

Corner not esltablished in the original survey of 1881 by Meldrum and Campbell.



No record of subsequent remonumentation was found in county records. Description of corner evidence found:


Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At corner position I set 2 1/2" X 30" iron pipe with brass cap marked as shown 22" in ground, from which:
A 24" Pine bears N 83° E, 61.0 ft. marked N 1/16 S19 BT.
A 12" Pine bears N 75° W, 28.0 ft. marked N 1/16 S24 BT.
