
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner established in 1881 by Meldrum and Campbell under General Land Office Contract No. 380. Surveyor General Records states:

Set basalt stone16" X 8" X 6" in mound of stone for 1/4 section cor.



No record of subsequent remonumentation was found in county records. Description of corner evidence found:

None

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At proportionate distance I set 2 1/2" X 30" iron pipe with brass cap marked as shown 16" in ground, from which:

A 6" Juniper bears S 48° E, 86.2 ft. marked 1/4 S19 BT.

A 10" Pine bears N 52° W, 100.4 ft. marked 1/4 S24 BT.

Raised mound of stone 5 ft. at base to top of cap.

Set steel fence post 5+ ft. North.
