No record of subsequent remonumentation found in County Records.

Description of corner evidence found:

I did not find the original corner post. I establish this corner at record bearing and distance from 2 original bearing trees as follows: From the corner point:

A 31" pine stump bears N. 12° W. 46.9 ft. mkd. "B" in blaze that I opened. Blaze is 9 inches from center of tree. The remains of a dead and down 28" pine blowdown bears S. 41° E. 38.9 ft. I found one axe mark about where the scribing blaze would have been, the blaze and scribing are completely weathered out.
A 34" pine bears S. 47° W. 59.5 ft. mkd. R.30E. T6S. on old fire scar. This tree is leaning badly.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the corner point: Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ "x30" iron pipe 30" in the ground with brass cap marked as shown. From which I scribe NEW BEARING TREES:

A 10" fir bears S. 32° E. 21.3 ft.mkd. T6S R30E S4 CC BT. A 20" fir bears S. 21° W. 31.2 ft. mkd. T6S R30E S5 CC BT.

I nailed a brass washer marked "OPLS 598" to BT blaze of both trees. Set a steel fence post 5' West of corner. Corner is 8 ft. North of E-W fence line. Used compass with 20° E. variation and steel tape, measuring to the center of the new BTs.
