
History of original corner establishment:

Unsurveyed - subdivided section



No record of subsequent remonumentation found in County Records.

Description of corner evidence found:

None.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" iron pipe 18" in ground with a brass cap marked as shown: From which I scribed Bearing Trees.

A 9" pine bears N. 26^000° W. 13.6 ft. mkd. CE 1/16 S.2 BT. A 8" pine bears S. 23^047° E. 25.7 ft. mkd. CE 1/16 S.2 BT.

Nailed a brass washer mkd. PLS 933 on the BT blaze of both trees. Set steel fence post 3 ft. West of corner. Corner is 30 ft. South of E-W road. Raised mound stone 3 ft. base within 2" of top of pipe. Used transit and steel tape, measuring to the center of BTs.
