A 10" fir bears S. 33 $^{\rm o}47$ ' E. 54.9 ft. mkd. E. 1/16 CC S.2 BT. A 10" fir bears S. 39 $^{\rm o}17$ ' W. 25.6 ft. mkd. E. 1/16 CC S.2 BT.

Nailed a brass washer mkd. P.L.S. 933 on the BT blaze on both trees. Set a steel fence post 3.5 ft. East of corner. The corner is 14 ft. South of a E-W fence line. Raised mound of stone 3 ft. base within 3" of top of pipe. Used transit and steel tape, measuring to center of BTs.
