
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment: Corner established in 1881 by Frank W. Campbell, under Contract No. 380

Surveyor General Record States:

40.00 set a basalt stone 10x10x10 in a mound of stone for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.

Pine 24" in diam. brs. N. 25° E. 7 1ks. dist.



No record of subsequent remonumentation found in County Records. Description of corner evidence found:

Fd. basalt stone 10"x8"x7" dimly marked 4, loosely set in a mound of stone from which the ORIGINAL BEARING TREE:

A 26" Pine bears N. 25° E. 4.6 ft. mkd. 4 in blaze that has been opened years ago.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the corner point: Set a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ "x30" iron pipe 16" in the ground with brass cap mkd as shown. From which I scribe one NEW BEARING TREE:

A 16" pine bears N. 61° W. 41.1 ft. mkd. T6S R30E 4 S2 BT.

I nailed a brass washed marked "OPLS 598" to the BT blaze of the tree. Set steel fence post 5 ft. south of corner. Buried original corner stone East and alongside pipe. Raised a mound of stone, 3 ft. base to within 5" of top of pipe. Corner is 30 ft. South of logging road. Used compass with 20° east variation, measuring to the center of the new BT.
