
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Unsurveyed - subdivided section



No record of subsequent remonumentation found in County Records.

Description of corner evidence found:

None.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" iron pipe in the ground with brass cap marked as shown: From which I scribed Bearing Trees.

A 9" pine bears N. $56^{0}47^{\circ}$ W. 12.6 ft. mkd. CS 1/16 S.3 BT. A 9" pine bears S. $46^{0}42^{\circ}$ W. 35.0 ft. mkd. CS 1/16 S.3 BT.

Nailed a brass washer mkd. PLS 933 to the BT blaze of both trees. Set a steel fence post 3 ft. west of corner. Raised mound of stone 3 ft. base within 3" of top of pipe. Used transit and steel tape measuring to the center of BTs.
