Set $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" iron pipe 18" in ground with brass cap marked as shown: From which I scribed to Bearing Trees:

A pine 18" bears N. 49° W. 38.5 ft. mkd. CS1/16 S1 BT. A pine 18" bears N. 16°30E. 48.5 ft. mkd. CS1/16 S1 BT.

I nailed a brass washer mkd. "PLS 933" to the BT blaze of both trees. Set steel fence post 4 ft. East of corner. Raised mound of stone 2 ft. base to within 3" of top of pipe. Used transit and steel tape, measuring to the center of BTs.

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
