At the corner point: Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ "x30" galvanized iron pipe 25" in the ground with a brass cap marked as shown. From which I scribe NEW BEARING TREES:

A 15" pine bears S. 77° E. 59.3 ft. mkd. T6S R30E S12 BT.
