
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment: Corner established in 1881 by Henry Meldrum, under Contract No. 380.

Surveyor General Record States:

40.00 set a pine post for 1/4 Sec. cor. from which:

A fir 16 in. in dia. brs N. 65° W., 11 lks distant. A fir 11 in. in dia. brs S. 70° E., 25 lks distant.



No record of subsequent remonumentation found in County Records.

Description of corner evidence found:

I did not find the original corner post. I establish this corner at record bearing and distance from the remains of the original BT stump in Sec. 1.

From the corner point, the ORIGINAL BEARING TREE:

The remains of a 12" fir stump partially rotted bears N. 65° W. 7.3 ft. with axe marks and healing scar visible in bark and thin layer of wood.

A dead and down 5" fir bears S. 85° E. 13.0 ft. mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT. This tree has slid down hill and I could not tell where it originally stood.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the corner point: Set a 2½"x30" galvanized iron pipe 27" in the ground with brass cap marked as shown: From which I scribe NEW BEARING TREES:

A 6" fir bears N. 41° E. 28.1 ft. mkd T6S R31E $\frac{1}{4}$ S6 BT. A 10" fir bears S. 8° W. 19.5 ft. mkd T6S R30E $\frac{1}{4}$ S1 BT.

I nailed a brass washer marked "OPLS 598" to the BT blaze of both trees. Set a steel fence post 5 ft. West of corner. Corner is 55 feet South of dry creek bed and ravine. Used compass with 20° East variation and steel tape measuring to center of new BTs.
