History of original corner establishment:

This corner was originally established by Rufus S. Moore on July 4, 1881 under his GLO contract number 382, as follows:

Set a başalt stone 24" x 12" x 8" and dug pits for the corner to sections 17, 18, 19 and 20.

Description of corner evidence found:

Found a basalt stone, 23" x 14" x 9" tipped to the west. The stone is marked with 3 grooves on the south face and one groove on the west face.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Moving the corner stone aside, I set in it's place a 2 $1/2" \times 30"$ aluminum pipe 26" into the ground in a mound of stones. A 3 1/4" aluminum cap attached is marked as shown in the diagram above. I bury the corner stone along the northwest side of the pipe, from which:

A 22" Ponderosa Pine bears S62°W, 90.4 feet scribed "T6S R31E S19 BT".

A 25" Ponderosa Pine bears N67°30'E, 144.4 feet scribed "T6S R31E S17 BT".

A 19" Ponderosa Pine bears S19°30'E, 139.1 feet scribed "T6S R31E S20 BT".

A 24" Ponderosa Pine bears N32°45'W, 79.8 feet scribed "T6S R31E S18 BT".

The bearing trees have a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636", nailed flush to the lower blaze and have sign 54-3, Bearing Tree, nailed above the blazes and sign 54-9, Land Survey Monument, nailed to the back of the
