
## TOWNSHIP I SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST, OF THE WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN, OREGON

A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents a dependent resurvey of a portion of the Willamette Base Line, through Rs. 32 and 33 E., and a portion of the west boundary and subdivisional lines, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the subdivision of section 6, T. 1 S., R. 33 E., Willamette Meridian, Oregon.

Except as indicated hereon, the lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved June 14, 1890 and supplemental plat accepted February 18, 1919.
