	<p>First tree of clump of Cottonwoods on same creek, N.23° 48'E., dist. 1½ miles.</p> <p>Chimney on house, dist. 15 chs., S.37°17'W,</p> <p>Made excavation; deposited bones. Planted a charred tamarack, 5 ft. long, & 4 ins. sq. Built mound, 5 ft. sq. & 3 ft. high, earth packed & sodded; deep rectangular trench with 4 pits of the usual size, post marked on W. side</p>
1/2 M.	<p>"½ M". Thence over rolling prairie, unimproved, 2nd rate soil, ascend slightly to end of 80 chs. on N.E. slope of hill.</p> <p>Bearings:</p> <p>To log house, N.74°27'E., dist. 2 miles.</p> <p>To steeple of Baptist Church in town, N.23°17'W., dist. 5 miles.</p> <p>To bare rock on Mt. side, S.38°30'E., dist. 8 miles.</p> <p>There is a high hill, just S. & S.W.</p> <p>Made excavation; deposited bones & charcoal. Planted a</p>
32 M	<p>large alder post, 10 ft. long & 9 ins. sq., top bevelled sides trimmed; ground end charred; marked on N. side</p>
1864	<p>"W", on S. "O", on E. "46° L 1864" and on W. side "32 M".</p>
June 16	<p>Mound, 7 ft. sq. at base & 5 ft. high; earth packed & sodded. Dug deep rectangular trench & 4 pits at the cardinal points. Land rolling prairie, soil 2nd rate.</p> <p>Thence E. over N. side of ridge into flat, 2.12 chs. S. of ditch, enclosing cultivated field of Mr. Wissack, ends the 40 chs.</p> <p>Bearings:</p>
1/2 M.	<p>To ridge of house, N.68°58'E., dist. 1 mile.</p> <p>Ridge of Catholic Seminary, in town, N.28°23'W., dist. 5 miles.</p> <p>Chimney of small frame house, S.70°29'E.</p> <p>Deposit, post, marking, trench, mound & pits, the same as the last ½ mile mound. Thence descend slight depression in prairie to end of 80 chs.</p> <p>Bearings:</p> <p>To edge of timber on Mt. peak, N.73°47'E., dist. 18 miles.</p>
