A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents a dependent resurvey of portions of the west boundary, subdivisional lines and subdivision-of-section lines of section 6, T. I. N., R. 33 E., Willamette Meridian, Oregon, designed to restore the corners in their frue original locations according to the best available evidence, and the subdivision of a portion of section 6.

Measured distances and directions have been adjusted by Cadastral Measurement Management (CMM), computer software that incorporates a least squares adjustment routine. The adjusted bearings and distances are reported to the nearest second and 0.01 foot.
