	<p>North between secs. 13 and 18.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Var. 19°45'E.</p> <p>Along the E. side of mountain in large windfall and dense undergrowth over point of rocky ridge, course E. and W.</p> <p>5.00 Descend through fir timber.</p> <p>40.00 Set post 3½ ft. long, 3 ins. square, 18 ins. in the ground on N. hillside in fir timber with dense underbrush, 60 ft. above bottom of ravine for ¼ sec.</p>
