40.00	Set post, 3½ ft. long, 3 ins. sq., 18 ins. in ground, on hillside sloping E., in dense timber and underbrush, for ¼ Sec. Cor., marked ¼ S. on E. & W. faces. A spruce, 11 ins. diam., brs. S.66° E., 8 lks. dist., marked ¼ S., B.T. A tamarack, 10 ins. diam., brs. S. 38° W., 24 lks. dist. marked ¼ S., B.T. Ascend through thicket of young timber.
44.00	Leave thicket and descend through heavy timber.
80.00	A fir tree, 13 ins. diam., which I marked for Cor. to Secs. 7, 12, 13 & 18. T.1 S., S.7 on N.E. R.36 E., S.18 on S.E. R.35 E., S.18 on S.W. S.12 on N.W. faces with 4 notches on S. and 2 notches on N. edges, from which A fir, 11 ins. diam., brs. S.10°W., 17 lks. dist., marked T.1 S., R.35 E., S.13, B.T. A fir, 10. ins. diam., brs. S.83° E., 14 lks. dist., marked T.1 S., R.36 E., S.18, B.T. A fir, 10. ins. diam., brs. N.13° E., 17 lks. dist., marked T.1 S., R.36 E., S.7, B.T. No other tree in limits ; made mound of stone alongside. Land; high, broken and mountainous. Soil; rocky, 3rd rate. Timber; pine, fir and tamarack.
