N.48°W., 11 lks. dist., marked T.1 N., S.33, B.T. A fir, 12 ins. diam., brs. S.54°E., 44 lks. dist., marked T.1 S., S.4, B.T. Land; mountainous. Soil; 2nd rate. Heavy pine, fir and tamarack timber. Dense undergrowth of pine, fir, willow and laurel. Sept. 26, 1882.
