General Description

The quality of the land in this Township is about an average. There is a very fair proportion of good, first rate soil, situated on both sides of the Umatilla River, also a large amount of good, second rate soil. The uplands is fine grazing land, being covered with rich bunch grass.

The Umatilla River is a beautiful stream of water; rapid current, low banks and averages about 200 links in width at low water.
