19.04	<p>Summit of ridge and field of grain and intersect U. R. bdy. Set stone 12 x 12 x 10 ins., 8 ins. in the ground for U.R.C.C. Closing Corner marked U.R.C.C. on E. face, S.17 on N. and S. face. Dug pits 18 x 18 x 12 ins., E. N. & S. from stone $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. distant and raised a mound of earth 2 ft. high, $4\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base over it. Descend.</p>

W. of true cor. on W. bank of creek for witness corner, marked 4 notches on S. & E. edges and W.C. on E. face, from which a Balm 18 in. diam. bears S. 42° E. 1.11 chs. dist., marked T. 2 N. S. 16 W.C.B.T., and a Balm 24 in. diam. bears N. 82° W. 1.70 chs. dist., marked R. 32 E. S. 8 W.C. B.T., and raised a mound of stone alongside; thence S. on true line.</p>
