Well preserved to cor. secs. 9-10-15 & 16. A post

S.15 R.33 E. on S.E.; S.16 on S.W. & S.9 on N.W. faces.

No notches. I cut 3 on E. and 4 on S. edges. Pits

filled with sand and mound about gone.

West between secs. 9 & 16.

Passed 1/16 - 1/4 - & 1/16 corners; all right except pits filled with sand at two of them. Found cor. secs. 8, 9, 16 & 17 post broken off and split fragment 24 x 4 x 4 ins. marked S.9, T.2 N. on N.E.; S.16 R.33 E. on S.E.; S.17 on S.W. & S.8 on N.W. faces, with 4 notches on E. & S. edges. Mound and pits partly destroyed, Reset post.

Found corner sections 20, 21, 28 & 29, a post 4 ft. long, by 4 ins. square, marked S.21, R.33 E. on N.E.; S. 28 on S.E.; S.29 on S.W.; and S.20 T.2 on N.W. faces.

Cut 4 notches on E. & 2 on S. edges. Cut off the T & R marks and put T. 2 N. on N. E. & R. 33 E. on S.E. faces.

Pits and mound very well preserved.
