35.25	Meacham Creek, 50 lks. wide, runs N.E.
40.00	Set a basalt stone 16 x 8 x 6 ins., 11 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face, from which, A pine, 26 ins. in diam. bears N.70° E. 22 lks, dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S.B.T. A fir, 6 ins. in diam. bears S. 80° W. 40 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S.B.T.
44.00	Meacham Creek, course N.W.
62.00	Graded road bed of the Baker City Railway line, course N.30° 45' W.
63.00	Ascend mountain.
80.00	Set a post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square, 24 ins. in the ground for cor. to secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32, marked T 2 N. S.29 on N.E. ; R 36 E. S32 on S.E.; S 31 on S.W., and S 30 on N.W. faces, with 1 notch on S and 5 notches on E. edges, from which A pine, 12 ins. in diam. bears S.30° W. 203 lks. dist., marked T 2 N.R 36 E. S31 B.T. A pine, 10 ins. in diam. bears N.60° W. 220 lks. dist., marked T 2 N.R.36 E. S30 B.T. ; no other tree within limits and raised a mound of stone around post. Land, mountainous and level. Soil, sandy loam and stony, 2nd & 3rd rate. Timber, scattering pine, fir and tamarack. Dense under-growth of pine, fir and buck brush.
	East on a random line bet. secs. 29 & 32. Var. 20° East. Ascend mountain. Set temporary $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. Intersect 55 lks. N. of the cor. to secs. 28, 29, 32 & 33. Thence, I run N.89° 36' West on a true line bet. secs. 29 & 32.
