S. 10 B.T.</p> <p>A fir, 10 ins. in diam., bears S. 43° E., 71 lks. dist., marked T. 2 N., R. 36 E., S. 15, B. T.</p> <p>A fir, 12 ins. in diam., bears S. 7° W., 299 lks. dist., marked T. 2 N., R. 36 E., S. 16, B.T.</p> <p>A fir, 5 ins. in diam. bears N. 18° W., 109 lks. dist., marked T. 2 N., R. 36 E., S. 9, B.
