	Set basalt stone, 28 x 10 x 6 ins., 21 ins. in ground, at point of temp. Cor., for true Cor. to Secs. 1, 6, 7, & 12, marked 5 notches on S. and 1 notch on N. Raised mound of stone, 3 ft. high x 4½ ft. base over Cor., on E. hillside. Var. 25°30' E.	
	At the point of intersection of line bet. Secs. 6 & 7, with W. Bdy. of Tp., I set a basalt stone, 26 x 10 x 8 ins., 20 ins. in ground, for Closing Cor. to Secs. 6 & 7, marked 1 notch on N. & 5 notches on S. & C.G. on W.; dug pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins. N., S. & E. of stone, 5½ ft. dist. Raised mound of stone and earth, 2 ft. high x 4½ ft. base over Cor., on E. hillside. Var. 19°15' E.	
	No timber. Soil; stony 5th rate. The whole line passes over mountainous land.	
	S. bet. Secs. 7 & 8.	Descend 25°. Var. 19°45' E.

40.00	Set basalt stone, 14 x 10 x 8 ins., 10 ins. in ground, for ¼ Sec. Cor., marked ½ on W. face; dug pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins., N. & S. of Cor., 5½ ft. dist. Raised mound of earth, 1½ ft. high x 3 ft. base alongside, on hillside facing West.	
54.50	Summit of ridge, S.W. & N.E.	Descend 40° +300
80.00	Set basalt stone, 18 x 8 x 6 ins., 12 ins. in ground, for Cor. to Secs. 7, 8, 17 & 18, marked 4 notches on S., & 5 notches on E. face. Raised mound of stone, 1½ ft. high x 3½ ft. base over stone. Pits impracticable, on S. face of hill. No timber. Soil; stony 4th rate. Land; mountainous, 80.00 chs.
