S.33 on S.W. and S.34 on S.E. faces, with 1 notch on S. and 3 notches on E. edges, from which, A pine, 4 ins. diam., brs. N.55°E., 16 lks. dist., marked T.2 S., R.35 E., S.27, B.T. A pine, 5 ins. diam., brs. N.63°W., 31 lks. dist., marked T.2 S., R.35 E., S.28, B.T. A fir, 4 ins. diam., brs. S.79°W., 44 lks. dist., marked T.2 S., R.35 E., S.33, B.T. A pine, 16 ins. diam., brs. S.55°E., 15 lks. dist., marked T.2 S., R.35 E., S.34, B.T. Land; high & mountainous, general slope to W. Soil; 2nd rate. Heavily timbered with pine, fir & tamarack and Dense undergrowth of pine, fir & tamarack.
