General Description.

This Township of land is very desirable for grazing purposes and is good soil for wheat and oats. It is handsomely situated on the Walla Walla road, many sections are nearly level and producing the best quality of grass for all kinds of stock and an abundance of it. The Umatilla River runs through Section 31. The bottom is about one quarter of a mile wide and heavily timbered with Balm of Gilead, Alder, Willow, Crabapple, Haw, etc. The quality of the land on the river bluff is poor; the balance is good 2nd rate. The Umatilla River is about 150 to 200 links wide and runs generally in a Northwest course, overflowing its banks generally except the bluffs.
